SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

EAGLE 2.0 is an online assessment system available to students, teachers, and administrators. The system requires Internet access and is supported in PC and MAC environments. The following requirements will help users prepare their computer systems for the best experience with the EAGLE system.

COMPUTER REQUIREMENTS

All systems that meet the requirements below must have access to:

• High-Speed Internet connection

WINDOWS PC

PC (laptop or desktop) with one of the following operating systems and Internet Explorer browsers:

MAC

Mac computer with one of the following operating systems and Safari browsers:

OTHER DEVICES

At this time, EAGLE support is not provided for tablets (i.e. IPAD, Android mobile devices).



SETTINGS AND SOFTWARE REQUIREMENTS

SCREEN RESOLUTION

Recommended screen resolution is 1280 x 1024. Minimum screen resolution is 1024 x 768. Your screen resolution is most likely adjustable by going to **My Computer>Control**Panel>Display>Settings.

ADOBE INSTALLATIONS

Adobe Flash Player version 14 or a more recent version

Adobe Reader 11 or a more recent version

OTHER

When using Internet Explorer (any version) make sure View is set at 100% for PCs. If it is set over 100%, the information displayed on the screen may not align properly.

- Click on **View** from the top menu
- Click on **Zoom** and make sure it is set to 100%

JAVASCRIPT

JavaScript setting **enabled** in the Internet Explorer and Safari browser. Below are the following steps for ensuring this setting is being used:

Internet Explorer

- ➤ Select Tools>Internet Options>Security>Custom level
- > Scroll down until you see the section labeled **Scripting**
- ➤ Under Active Scripting, select Enable and click OK

MAC Safari

- > Select Safari>Preferences> Security
- > Select the checkbox next to **Enable JavaScript**

POP-UP BLOCKERS

Pop-up blockers must be turned **off** to view certain links on the EAGLE system. Internet Explorer



- To turn off the popup blocker in Internet Explorer 9.0 or higher, click Tools from the main menu bar located at the top of the screen
- > Select Popup Blocker
- > Click Turn Off Popup Blocker

Mac Safari

- > Select **Preferences** from Safari menu
- ➤ Click **Security**
- Make sure box to block pop-ups is checked

FIREWALLS

Ensure that the EAGLE IP Addresses are NOT blocked by your firewall and allow the following addresses:

- Ensure that the EAGLE shortcut being used is https:// and not http://

^{*}In most cases, you may also bypass a popup blocker by holding down the **CTRL** key on your keyboard for PCs and the **Command** key for the Mac as you click on a link and wait for it to open. Consult your local technician for other blockers.
