This is just a starting point. There are other things that will come up, so if you have any questions about something that may qualify, don't hesitate to ask.

Things that do not count as community service:

- 1) Jobs/activities with a sports team as a duty to the team, for example, washing team uniforms or cleaning fieldhouse.
- 2) Chores at your own home or families' homes.
- 3) Anything you get paid to do.
- 4) Babysitting
- 5) Service done during the summer (I want you active during the school year)
- 6) Activities at church unless it benefits people outside of church (for example, youth going to soup kitchen or cleaning up an elderly's yard, donating holiday foods or gifts are things that would count, not working in the nursery)
- 7) Things you do as a teacher cadet because you receive a grade for that.

The point of community service is going out of your way or normal activity to do things for others.
