

## STUDENT SUCCESS

Mangham High School students have many things to be proud of and they are continuing to make great strides in academics and extracurricular activities. One of the areas that we have seen much growth in is the school's ACT Index Score. ACT index includes ACT and WorkKeys assessment scores.

WorkKeys is an assessment that tests students' job skills in applied reading, writing, mathematics and essential skills. Scores are based on job profiles that help employers select, hire, train, develop and retain a high-performance workforce. It may increase opportunities for career changes and advancement in students' future employment because it measures a range of hard and soft skills relevant to any occupation, at any level, and across industries.

The goal is to score at least a Silver, but Gold and Platinum are also obtainable scores on the scale of achievement. As of now, the Class of 2025 has 30 students who have scored 18 or above on their ACT, 29 students who have scored Silver on WorkKeys and 2 students who have scored Gold. The next WorkKeys test is scheduled for February 20th and the deadline to register for the April 5th ACT is February 28th.
