The council will consist of at least eight members, 4 shall be parents of a child who receives special education services, 2 shall be a Richland Parish Principal, Teacher or Paraprofessional, and one shall be a special education stakeholder, and one a student advocate. Each member will be appointed for two school year terms and will act as an advisory council to the superintendent and/or the school board. The Richland SEAC will meet three times per school year.
